Update on pre-registration of all goods vehicles leaving Lithuania via the EU external border

From 1 December 2024, all goods vehicles leaving the Republic of Lithuania via the external border by road must be registered in the Queue Management Information System (EVIS) before arriving at the border checkpoint.

Goods vehicles can be registered in EVIS in advance online: <u>www.ltborder.lt</u>, <u>www.ltsiena.lt</u>, or by arriving at the vehicle waiting area at the border checkpoint.

Types of registration:

- pre-registration for a specific time, when the preferred border crossing time slot is selected during registration;
- pre-registration for goods vehicles, which are allowed to cross the state border of the Republic of Lithuania, without queuing under the procedure laid down by the legislation of the Republic of Lithuania;
- registration in EVIS for the next available time slot upon arrival at the vehicle waiting area.

The charges for EVIS registration and waiting areas remain unchanged (registration fee is EUR 5, and waiting area services are free of charge for the first hour and then EUR 12 are charged per vehicle per day).

Only goods vehicles that have been called from the waiting area are allowed to enter the border checkpoint. Vehicles may not be registered at the border checkpoint.
